PROSPECTUS FORM

Hinovations Art Gallery is accepting art submissions for the TEXICAN- group art exhibition. Hinovations Art Gallery invites artists that reside in Texas who have experienced “Cultural Blending”, to submit artwork for the Exhibition TEXICAN-. Artwork should be representative of Texas Cultural Blending and of modern-day Texas.

Artists should submit work to be featured during the months of September 2 to October 28, 2022.

Artists should submit work with the following criteria and adhere to rules in order to be accepted:

- The work must be representative or reflect Texas Cultural Blending in any desired art form or style.
- Artwork must be original work by the artist and not previously shown at Hinovations. Copies or reproductions of artists work are not eligible.
- Artwork must be recent and created within the last two years, from September 1, 2020 to now.
- The work can be in the following sizes: no smaller than 6 inches or larger than 60 inches, it can be executed on any surface as a drawing or painting in any dry or wet media, collage or sculpture.
- All framed artwork, paintings and sculpture should be ready for hanging or installation with appropriate weight-wire, tooth hangers or stands. All drawings must be framed.
- Works on canvas must be framed or have gallery-wrapped, finished edges with no staples visible.
- Frames must be in good condition, free of scratches and loose corners.
- Artwork must be available for sale. Hinovations Art Gallery retains a 35% commission.
- A maximum of up to two works of art will be accepted per artist pending approval by Gallery Director, Raquel Hinojosa and committee.
- Images can be submitted via email for approval to hinovationsartgallery@gmail.com.
- Submission Form must accompany the artwork or will not be accepted.
- Work accepted for an exhibition may not be substituted, nor will any artwork be withdrawn during any exhibition, in any circumstance.
- The number of pieces included in the exhibit will depend upon the space available and the size of the artworks selected. On average, this will be between 20 and 30 pieces.
- Hinovations reserves the right to turn away any submissions that it deems inappropriate for our younger viewers or offensive in subject matter.
- Works with overtly pornographic, discriminatory or violent messages may be barred from submission per the Hinovations’ Director.
- Work submitted will be pending approval by committee. Artists will be notified by email within a week or sooner, of submitting art for acceptance. Submit for approval no later than August 20, 2022.
- Artwork not meeting the above criteria will not be accepted.

Publicity/Press Reproduction - The undersigned grants Hinovations Art Gallery and its representatives the full rights to incorporate images of said artwork on the website and social media. The undersigned also consents to the use of images of said artwork in any printed matter and advertising and marketing materials use to promote the exhibition.

Liability – Hinovations Art Gallery, any of its members or employees will not be liable for loss or damage to any work submitted to this exhibition. The undersigned knowingly, freely and voluntarily waives any right or cause of action of any kind whatsoever arising as a result of loss, theft or destruction of or damage to the personal property placed upon the premises by the undersigned including but not limited to works of art or other materials from which liability may or could accrue Hinovations Art Gallery.

Pick up - If selected, artist must pick-up/remove artwork from the premises on the date indicated in the contract. Hand-delivered works must be picked up at the close of the exhibition or work becomes property of Hinovations Art Gallery to dispose of as it sees fit.
